

<b>Blazer</b>	<b>Regulation Harris Academy black blazer with Harris Academy logo and trimmings (compulsory for Yrs 7-11)</b>
<b>Pullover</b>	<b>Green V-neck with Harris Academy logo.</b> Optional – can only be worn UNDER the blazer. No other jumpers, cardigans, sweatshirts or waistcoats are permitted.
<b>Skirt/Trousers</b>	<b>Black, classic style.</b> Skirts should be of a sensible length (knee or calf length) and of traditional skirt material. Slits in skirts should be minimal in length. No side slits permitted. No jeans, washed grey, navy blue, corduroy, jean like material, high fashion trousers/leggings (no studs or trimmings), skinny trousers or shorts. Trousers/skirts should be worn on the waist not the hips.
<b>Shirt</b>	<b>Plain white school shirt (no fitted blouses),</b> tucked in and closed/buttoned/fastened at the neck. (Any polo neck/'T' shirt or underwear worn underneath should not show or be visible through the shirt).
<b>Tie</b>	<b>Correct Faculty colour</b> – in good condition with colour visible in the stripes and worn with a closed knot (The tie should be of a sensible length that reaches the waist).
<b>Socks</b>	<b>Plain black/white socks.</b> Worn below the knees.
<b>Tights</b>	<b>Plain natural/black.</b> No footless, patterned or fishnet tights or leggings.
<b>Shoes</b>	<b>Plain black shoes.</b> No trainers, ankle boots, knee-length boots, fabric shoes, pumps or shoes with open toes or open heels. No trimmings i.e. buckles, labels, tags or decorations. <b>Laces and stitching must be black. Black shoes should be worn on the way to and from the Academy. Students will not be allowed to attend lessons if trainers are worn in the Academy.</b>
<b>Coat</b>	<b>Plain black outdoor coat/jacket (no logos). Coats should not be worn when inside the Academy buildings.</b> No denim. Cardigans, jumpers, sweatshirts, tracksuit tops, waistcoats, hooded tops are not to be worn at the Academy.

<b>General</b>	Students are expected to be of smart and sensible appearance. Individual fashion statements such as extreme hair styles or colours, designer shirts, trainers and decorated footwear are not permitted. No decorative attachments are to be worn in the hair. Hair bands must be plain black or white with a maximum of 50mm width. Tram lines or other shaved shapes in the hair and 'bar codes' in eyebrows are not permitted. Make-up and nail varnish or nail extensions must not be worn at any time. Tinted or cosmetic contact lenses and decorative dental wear are not permitted. Black scarves, hats (no bandannas, hoods or caps) and gloves only to be worn and these must be removed once inside the Academy buildings. Hijabs worn for religious purposes and agreed by the Academy must be plain black, and must not cover either the face or uniform. <b>By requiring students to wear the Academy uniform, it is intended to develop their sense of loyalty to the community of which they are members, and to encourage them to take a pride in their appearance. Students are expected to wear full Academy uniform on the way to and from the Academy. Blazers are to be worn at all times other than when eating in the dining room or in lessons when a teacher has given permission for them to be removed.</b>
<b>Jewellery/ Valuables</b>	No jewellery except for one wrist watch and a maximum of one small plain silver or gold coloured (no stones) stud earring in each ear. Nose studs and other forms of body piercing are not permitted. No accessories are to be worn around the neck or attached to clothing. Large amounts of money and expensive personal effects should not be brought to the Academy. Harris Academy will not accept liability for any claim arising from theft, accidental loss or damage to personal effects, money, belongings or clothing whilst at the Academy. Ipods/MP3 players, mobile telephones, pagers, computer games, etc. <b>MUST NOT</b> be brought to the Academy. Jewellery and other forbidden items will be confiscated and only returned at the end of term. Money should be kept in purses, wallets or money belts. No other money pouches will be acceptable.

**If students are not in full uniform they will not be able to attend lessons. They will work outside in the inclusion unit until the correct uniform is brought to them or they will be sent home to change. All items of uniform should be clearly marked or labelled.**
